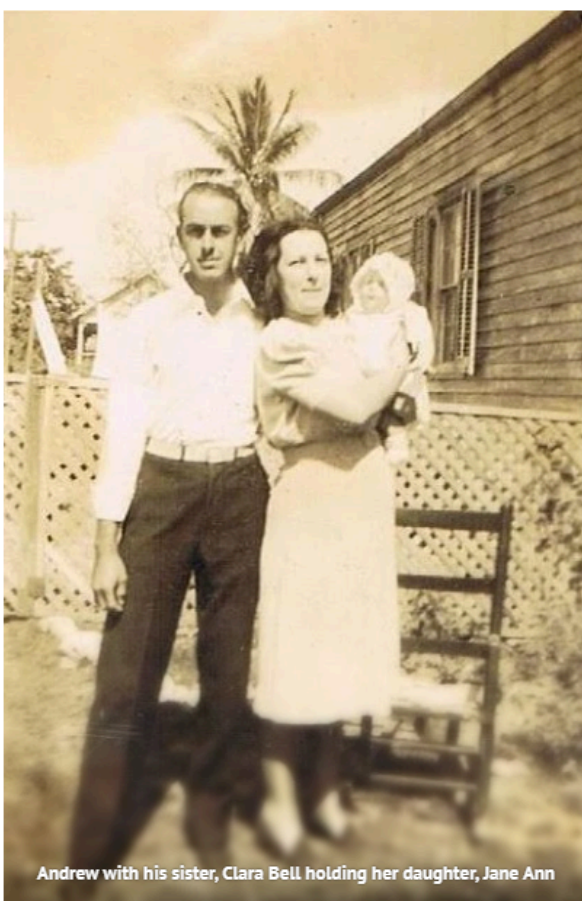

Lori Stiefle recalls,

“I know when I took him to Tampa on his birthday one year he and aunt Anola were sitting on the beach and were on Aunt Anola's bikes. My friend and I were pushing them up the beach and I saw a white head man and a dark skin woman. I told my friend that was papa and she said I was crazy because they hadn't had time to get there. Sure enough it was them. Papa took one of the bikes and started riding it around. It was hilarious.”

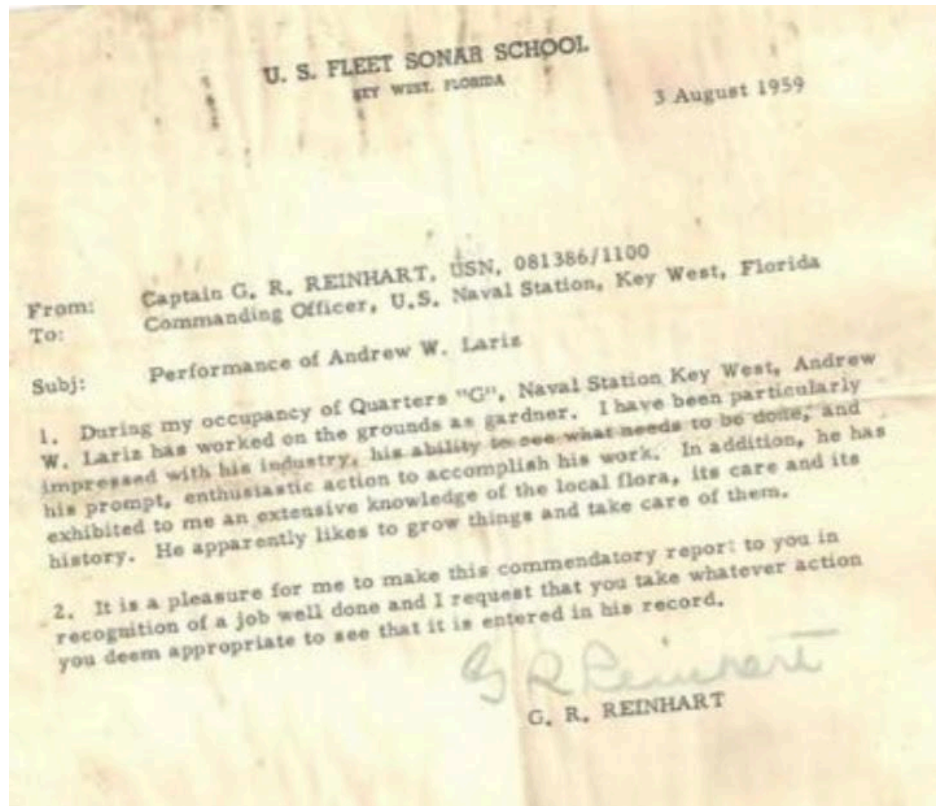


Clarie and Andrew on Big Coppitt Key

Andrew worked as a grounds gardener at the Naval Station in Key West. He received a commendation letter from Captain G. R. Reinhart of the U.S. Fleet Sonar School in Key West on August 3, 1959 for "his industry, his ability to see what needs to be done, and his prompt,

enthusiastic action to accomplish his work, extensive knowledge of the local flora, its care and its history."





LOSSES

- His brother was born on July 26, 1921, and passed away that same day.
- His half-sister Mercedes died on August 3, 1938, in Key West, Florida, when Andrew Woodrow (Bubby) was 19 years old.
- His half-sister Rosina Violet died on September 30, 1939, in Tampa, Florida, when Andrew Woodrow (Bubby) was 20 years old.
- His father Manuel Andres passed away on February 15, 1947, in Key West, Florida, at the age of 71.
- His half-brother John Andrew Rodriguez died on January 24, 1949, in Key West, Florida, when Andrew Woodrow (Bubby) was 29 years old.
- His half-brother Domingo Berardo died on July 14, 1957, in Key West, Florida, when Andrew Woodrow (Bubby) was 38 years old.
- His mother Clara Dena passed away on August 13, 1961, in Key West, Florida, at the age of 81.

- His sister Clara Belle died on November 11, 1965, in Greenville, South Carolina, when Andrew Woodrow (Bubby) was 46 years old.
- His half-sister Anna Maria died on August 23, 1968, in Tampa, Florida, when Andrew Woodrow (Bubby) was 49 years old.
- His wife Mabel passed away on June 28, 1987, at the age of 72. They had been married 47 years.

Andrew Woodrow (Bubby) Lariz died on February 25, 1995, when he was 75 years old. He was laid to rest in Greenville Memorial Gardens in Greenville, S.C.

Graveside services will be conducted 2:00 P.M. Tuesday in *Greenville Memorial Gardens* by Rev. Mahlon Helmuth.
